
SURVEY OF Canadian Electricity Bills



RATES AND REGULATORY DEPARTMENT

Effective May 1, 2015



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Each participating utility calculates bills based on its rates as of May 1, 2015.



All bills exclude federal, provincial or municipal taxes. Newfoundland Power does however include a Municipal Tax and Rate Stabilization Adjustment which is built into their rates.



Ontario – The Ontario Clean Energy Benefit (OCEB) 10% discount is applied on the first 3,000 kWh/ month for both Residential and General Service (Small loads).






