## Schedule 1 – Flat Rate Permit Fees – RESIDENTIAL SELFWIRE

<b>Minimum Permit Fee (Non-Refundable)</b>	\$220.00
<b>1 Single Dwellings</b>	
a) New single dwellings, 200 Amps or less (excluding service): (No additional equipment needs to be selected)	\$440.00
b) Alterations, additions and renovations: Includes a sub-panel and up to 20 devices maximum.	\$165.00
i) Devices in excess of 20, as per item 2, ii) Heating, cooling, motors and pumps, as per item 3.	
c) Residential garages, or similar outbuilding: Includes a sub-panel and up to 20 devices maximum.	\$220.00
i) Devices in excess of 20, as per item 2, ii) Heating, cooling, motors and pumps, as per item 3.	
d) Electric heating, air conditioning, heat pumps, boilers hot water tanks, pumps, motors or similar equipment: (Applies when this is the only equipment being installed)	\$110.00
e) Extra trip for additional inspection	\$110.00
f) Additional permit:	\$110.00
<b>2 Devices in excess of 20</b>	
Switches, receptacles, lights, fire alarm devices or similar equipment	
i) For the first 100 units, each:	\$2.50
ii) For the remaining units, each:	\$1.75
<b>3 Electric heating, cooling, motors, pumps similar equipment - HP/ kW/ kVA/ Ton</b>	
Each unit, including controls on the load side of the branch circuit overcurrent device:	
i) Fractional, each unit	\$6.00
ii) 1, but not over 4	\$15.00
iii) Larger than 4, but not over 25	\$28.25

<b>8 Special inspection prior to reconnection of existing residential consumers services disconnected for 6 months or longer, or for dwelling units located within Riding Mountain National Park boundaries</b>	
Fee per unit	\$220.00
