

Natural Gas Quarterly Rate Change on November 1, 2023

Effective November 1, 2023, the Gas Commodity rate is decreasing from 13.52¢ to 10.21¢ per cubic metre, and the Delivery rate is decreasing from 12.47¢ to 12.41¢ per cubic metre. The combined bill impact for the typical residential customer's annual natural gas bill is a decrease of approximately 10.0 per cent or \$75 per year. For larger volume customers, annualized bill impacts will range from decreases of 10.9 per cent to 20.4 per cent depending on customer rate class and consumption. These decreases are the result of changes in the price Manitoba Hydro pays for natural gas.

The Gas Commodity and Delivery rates are adjusted each gas quarter (February, May, August, and November) for increases or decreases to the forecast costs of natural gas supply. Manitoba Hydro earns no profit on the sale of Gas Commodity. The price the utility pays is passed directly on to customers with no markup – you pay what we pay.

We offer customers the option of paying their natural gas bills in equal monthly payments through our Equal Payment Plan.
