- Indicates Manitoba Hydro accepts and takes over the Work, or the unit section, as of the completion date subject to the provision of the contract respecting warranty;
- If applicable,
 - Performance Holdback can be released (usually 30 days after completion date);
 - Builders Lien Act Holdback can be released in accordance with the provision of the [Builders' Lien Act](#) (usually 40 days after completion date)
