INDUSTRY NOTICE

Transformer Type Meter and Metering Transformer Enclosure/Compartment

Effective immediately, due to supply chain issues with test switches, Manitoba Hydro has made a temporary exception to allow the following 5-jaw Transformer Type Meter and Metering Transformer Enclosure/Compartment.

The following must be met:

- A Manitoba Hydro Electrical Permit is required for all these installations, including the City of Winnipeg
- The equipment must be approved for use in Canada.
- The product must be of the same manufacturers listed in the original industry notice dated October 4, 2017 posted on Manitoba Hydro Website
- There must be provision for test switch to be installed when available
- The shorting link is located at the 10:00 position.
- Socket is not installed upside down.
- Shorting link is not broken
- Must accommodate a 5 jaw meter

Once the test switches become available, the following must be met:

- Shorting Link must be removed
- The permit holder must notify Manitoba Hydro to schedule to install the test switches.
- For the installation of the test switches and removal of the shorting link the permit holder must:
 - schedule a disconnect / reconnect with district
 - schedule electrical inspections to inspect
 - schedule the metering technician to wire the test switches
