

Manitoba Electrical Code Inspection Notice

14-614 Current supply from more than one system

Immediately
Scope:
To clarify what needs to be done when you have more than one supply from different systems

Requirements:

Effective Date:

Rule 14-614

Rule 14-614 is added to the code after 14-612

Where an installation, or part of an installation, is to be supplied with current from two or more different systems, the switching equipment controlling the various supplies shall be constructed or arranged so that it will be impossible to accidentally switch on power from one source before power from another has been cut off.

Rationale:

Manitoba Hydro requires that this switching equipment be arranged so that power from one source cannot be switched on unless power from another source has been cut off.
