



LANDSCAPING AROUND A PADMOUNT TRANSFORMER IN YOUR YARD

Follow these guidelines to incorporate a padmount transformer into your landscaping plan without compromising safety or function.

Remember to Click Before You Dig if you plan to dig more than 15 cm.

LANDSCAPING GUIDELINES

- Follow species list provided for lot size. See examples on pages 2 to 4.
- Do not plant on padlock side of unit. Please allow at least 3 metres of clearance for maintenance and repairs on the transformer.
- Final soil grade to be 20 cm below top of pad.
- Do not plant between the transformer and the MTS pedestal.
- Fill-in plantings are permitted.
- Place planting stock according to grids provided on page 2 to 4.

3. Goldflame Spirea




PADMOUNT TRANSFORMERS IN YOUR YARD

2 PLANTING ON A LOT OVER 15 METRES WIDE (OPTION 1)

Deciduous and evergreen trees can be used interchangeably.

- 1 Coronation Triumph Potentilla
- 2 Compact American Cranberry Bush
- 3 Goldflame Spirea
- 4 Cream Edge Dogwood
- 5 Weeping Peashrub Caragana
- 6 Red Osier Dogwood



PADMOUNT TRANSFORMERS IN YOUR YARD

3 PLANTING ON A LOT OVER 15 METRES WIDE (OPTION 2)

Deciduous and evergreen trees can be used interchangeably.

- 1 Coronation Triumph Potentilla
- 2 Blue Danube Juniper
- 3 Golden Pfitzer Juniper
- 4 Cream Edge Dogwood
- 5 Weeping Peashrub Caragana
- 6 Darts Gold Ninebark
